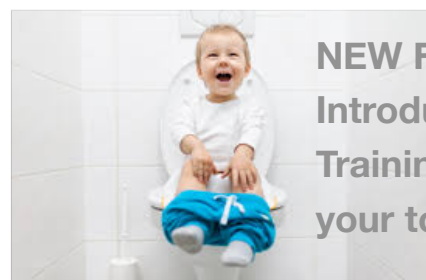
Who Qualifies

- Parents, Grandparents, Legal Guardians, Foster Parents, and Veterans with babies ages 0-4

What to Bring

At each monthly visit we need to see the following:

Dated WIC print out, an up to date WIC App. (*You do not need to be a WIC client*) or statement of your wages from your employer, or a current letter from the Transitional Assistance Office, an ID, and Proof of address on Cape Cod or the Islands (example -utility bill)

- One on one time with an intake professional to check in and discuss your current needs
- Resource assistance
- Caring staff and volunteers to assist you as you navigate our center.
